





The Podium floor plan The Largest Single Office Floor Plate in Manchester City Centre





Heritage and purpose

The most sustainable way of creating workspace is to use what already exists and City Tower has stood the test of time.

In 1959, architects Covell Matthews and Partners unveiled their radical plans for the creation of an exciting new space. Bold and unorthodox at the time, the scheme comprised three towers which sat atop a podium that ran the entire length of Parker Street.

The man chosen to make it all happen was Bernard Sunley, one of the most successful property developers to come out of the 1950's building boom. The three towers, Bernard House, Sunley House and Piccadilly Hotel were completed and in 1965, Piccadilly Plaza officially opened its doors. (Legend has it that it was a non-negotiable condition of Sunley's taking the job that the towers would bear his name.)

The building's central location also connects you to the vibrant soul of Manchester, where every street corner is bursting with life and character.








St Peter's Square
